Position Description

Canal Alliance is seeking an ESL Teacher for the Spring Semester (January 27 – April 30, 2020) to provide intensive English classes to English language learners, and ensure students gain the skills necessary to advance to the next level. The ESL Teacher reports to the ESL Manager. A successful candidate will integrate relevant teaching practices in grammar, writing, listening-speaking and reading and be a passionate believer in the power of education to improve the lives of immigrants and their families. Candidates should have the ability to work Monday through Thursday nights from 8-10pm and attend a mandatory training on Monday, January 13 from 6:30-9:00pm.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide a nurturing, supportive, and positive learning environment, with high expectations for students
- Prepare and deliver lesson plans in line with Communicative Language Teaching, program goals, philosophy, and curriculum
- Build positive and respectful relationships with students
- Communicate consistently and assist in identifying needs of students
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance
- Administer and grade assessments throughout the semester
- Monitor student progress
- Modify instructional program of students based on student data
- Participate in one professional development session each semester
