If under 18, you must be accompanied by parent/quardian.


AVAILABILITY

The Bilingual Outreach Volunteer performs various roles depending on the event or activity. Schedules will vary between 2-4 hours per activity.





Responsibilities

- Complete training to learn to answer questions that may arise as part of an education or outreach activity.
- Share information with the public, assist with table/booth operations at various locations/events including set up and take down of booth materials, and help with tracking event details and outcomes.

Skills & Competencies

SPANISH PROFICIENCY IS REQUIRED as the volunteers will be providing education and outreach. Canal Alliance is a trusted messenger in the Latino immigrant community and the ability to communicate effectively is key to delivering a message on why the census is important to the Latino immigrant community.
