Without Measures G & H, San Rafael schools will lose nearly \$10 million each year and deep cuts will be required.

All funds from Measures G & H go directly to our local schools. No funds can be taken away by the State and no funds can be used for administrator salaries.

- Seniors will continue to be eligible for an exemption
